The Section 64 of World Draughts Federation (FMJD) and Polish Draughts Federation according to the calendar 2009 and competitions' regulations FMJD Section-64 will organize the personally-command World Draughts Championship of Section-64 among young men and women. Championship will be held in the c. Mława (Poland) on 22 August (arrival day) till 30 August 2009.

Championship will be held separately for both boys and girls in four age groups: Juniors 1990-92, 1993-95, 1996-98 and expectation 1999 and under. Competitions in age groups Juniors (1990-92) and expectation (1999 and under) are held for Brazilian version of draughts 64, and others – on Russian version of draughts 64.

There will be three types of the program: blitz with the control 3 minutes (1996 and under – 5 minutes) before the end of game, the rapid game with the control 10 minutes before the end of game and the classic game with the control 45 minutes for the first 25 moves and then 15 minutes before the end of the game. The system is Swiss or circular, in depending of the number of participants.

All types of the program will be played according to the mykro-match system consisted of 2 games. In the competitions juniors and cadets with drawing of the first move of white, obligatory in both games of mykro-match. In summarizing command outcome teams shall be determined most amount points Recruited of 8 best players in tournaments – one person from every age group in the competitions on classical game. Command results separately for commands of young men and girls on the greatest sum of points, typed by 4 best participants on one in each age group in competitions on classical game are brought also. Champions of the world and Europe of different years, prize-winners of championships of the world and Europe in 2008, and participants declared by national Federations are admitted to the championship. Organizational tournament fee for each participant should be paid on the day of arrival: for three representatives from each country among boys and among girls the fee is 45 (forty five) euros for participation in the program with the classic control and 10 (ten) euros in blitz and 10 (ten) euros in rapid game. For the other representatives from all countries the fee is 90 (ninety) euros for participation in the program with the classic control and 20 (twenty) euros in blitz and rapid game. The organizational committee provides with housing and meals four participants (on one in each of four age groups) from each country. Travel expenses for everybody, as well as expenses for housing and meals for the other participants should be covered by sending organizations.

Application forms for participation in the championship should be presented to Section 64 not later than July, 22, 2009. In the demand should be indicated: a surname, a name (with a writing as in the passport), number, month, a year of birth, a series and passport number. All participants should have the medical insurance for competitions. For participants from the countries having a visa regime with Poland, invitations for the purpose receptions of free visas will be sent.
